PRESS MODE AND CHOOSE 

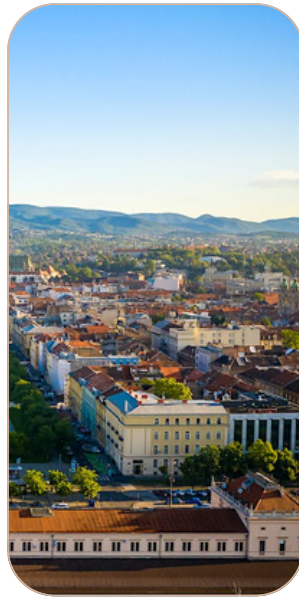
